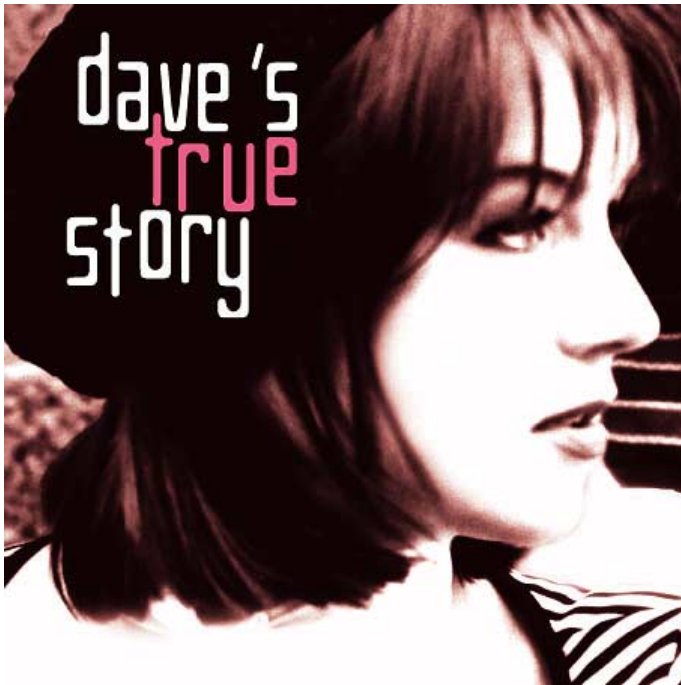


dave's true story

"Dave's True Story" - the 2002 version
Release date: April 1, 2002

As the story goes, Dave and Kelly first got together on a snowy evening in Manhattan back in 1989. That very well may be so, but it wasn't until their first CD was released in 1994 that the word about Dave's True Story really started to spread.

"Dave's True Story", a collection of 11 quirky songs originally released in 1994, introduced the world to the smooth, sultry vocal of Kelly Flint singing the skillfully scripted, sometimes twisted songs of David Cantor. The CD achieved cult status almost immediately in those pre-mp3, pre-www days and was picked up and promoted by the Hear Music chain. In addition to winning the prestigious Kerrville New Music award that year, they received widespread and local support from audiences and DJ's (such as Vin Scelsa, Rita Houston and Jonathan Schwartz) and became darlings of the press (half-page article in the Sunday New York Times). All of this resulted in the sales of more than 10,000 copies of that 1st CD. Dave's True Story went on to make two records for the Chesky label, both of which sold well and worldwide and between the three albums they have sold upwards of 50,000 copies. They had a minor hit in Holland with their song, "Ned's Big Dutch Wife" (resulting in their sold-out performance at The Paradiso Club in Amsterdam) and their version of Lou Reed's "Walk On The Wild Side" was stocked in juke boxes and spun by DJ's throughout Europe. Katarina Witt, upon hearing their music in Germany, asked them to be the band for her television special, "Divas On Ice" which aired January 6th, 2001 on NBC. They have been featured on two best-selling compilation records, "Next Generation Swing" which sold over 320,000 copies and the NARM Recordings "For the Love Of Jazz" which was picked by Billboard Magazine as one of the top-10 Contemporary Jazz Albums of 2000. Pottery Barn has featured them on two of their compilation CDs, noteworthy simply because they are in the company of such luminaries as Ella Fitzgerald, Louis Armstrong, BB King, Patti Page and Leon Redbone. Not bad for an independent band whose notoriety has occurred almost entirely through word of mouth.



Once people had purchased CDs 2 and 3 ("Sex Without Bodies" and "Unauthorized"), demand increased for the out-of-print, first CD. A fan spotted a used copy of the first album being sold on eBay for \$65.00. Fast forward to 2002.

The New Year brought news that a film DTS had 'lent' music to, KISSING JESSICA STEIN, had been picked up for distribution by Fox Searchlight

Pictures and would be released theatrically nationwide in March. The DTS song "Crazy Eyes" is the musical accompaniment to *the* key kissing scene and in those seconds of breathless cinematic silence, Kelly's cooing, "You've got a blue eye..." absolutely crowns the moment.

Later on in the film, a bit of the song, "Sequined Mermaid Dress" can be heard. As the March release date neared, buzz on the film increased and to our delight it was very, very Positive.

"'Crazy Eyes' is one of the most asked about songs from KISSING JESSICA STEIN", says Jennifer Westfeldt, co-writer of the film and the actress who plays Jessica Stein. However, if you go to buy the Verve Records soundtrack, you will not find the Dave's True Story songs on it - such is the plight of the independent artist. But when one door closes, another opens and given the circumstances, the group felt this was a perfect opportunity to re-release **"Dave's True Story"**, which features both "Crazy Eyes" and "Sequined Mermaid Dress."

And here you have it: **"Dave's True Story"** for the new millennium with some new life breathed into it. The 2002 version has been meticulously remastered from the original mixes by Scott Hull at Classic Sound in New York City. Four previously unreleased bonus tracks have been added. The artwork has been re-designed from the original elements by Marina S. of Coma 2 Studios in Munich.

The heart and soul of this album, those 11 original tracks, sound as fresh, original and vital as they did nearly a decade ago when the tape rolled and Kelly counted off that first take. Enjoy.
